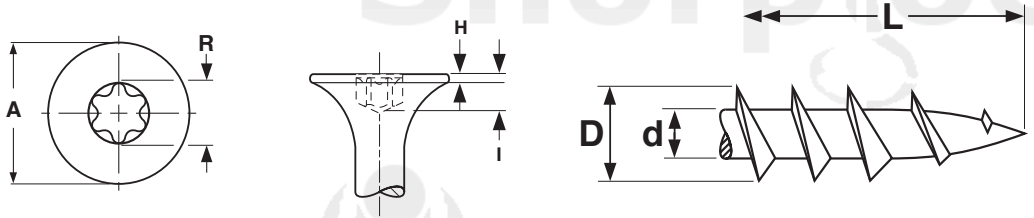

In the absence of a single industry standard for Deck Screws, these dimensions are offered as a guide; slight deviations are acceptable.									

<b>Description</b>	A bugle head screw with a six-lobe recess, spaced threads and extra sharp point.
<b>Applications/ Advantages</b>	For attaching wood trim or railing to fences. Type-17 point minimizes the chances of splitting wood. Stainless material offers superior resistance to corrosion. The square drive variety is preferred when greater torque is required during installation.
<b>Material</b>	Class 1018 - 1022 steel
<b>Hardness</b>	550 HV Minimum
<b>Breaking Torque</b>	#6: 23 Kg-cm min.; #8: 38 Kg-cm min.; #10: 60 Kg-cm min.
<b>Finish</b>	Screws are typically commercially passivated.
